

Dear Academy,

Our Spring Dance Concert is coming up in May. The class list per performance is attached. It is more important than ever that your child comes to class to practice for their dance(s). Your child will wear their usual class uniform and their hair in a bun.

We have Bun in a Bag (hairpins, elastics, comb & clips) for sale for \$5.

Hip Hop & Tap students will wear the required black WAB Logo t-shirts, black leggings, and hair in a bun. Here is a helpful video of [How to make the Perfect Ballet Bun](#). We will also have our Company members at the theatre on the day of the concert doing buns for \$5. I have attached an order form for the WAB Logo T-shirts. Anyone can order t-shirts but are required for Tap & Hip Hop students.

This year in lieu of an at-the-door admission fee, a Spring Dance Concert fee of \$30 per family (not per dancer) will be assessed on April 15, 2024. The fee is due by May 1, 2024. The fee will be run with May tuition for those enrolled in auto pay unless you contact the studio to instruct otherwise. The fee covers the cost of theatre rental. There are no additional fees associated with the end-of-year Spring Dance Concert.

- The last day to register and make up classes is February 29.
- Spring Break is March 16-22. The studio will be closed, with no classes or rehearsals.
- Spring Pictures for **all Academy Students** is the afternoon of Saturday, April 13. Scheduled by class. More details to come.
- Spring Dance Concerts are scheduled for Tuesday, May 21 & Wednesday, May 22 at 6 pm at the Breedlove Auditorium-UAFS. This is our end-of-the-year performance for all Academy dancers in Creative Movement and up. Rehearsals will be on the evening of Monday, May 20. The Monday rehearsal schedule will be sent at a later date.
